INTRODUCTION

The core principles of modern restorative dentistry are adhesion and minimal invasiveness. A deep understanding of the advantages and limitations of adhesive materials and techniques is crucial for all dentists. A superficial approach to cemented materials can lead to failures and excessive chair time.

In today's practice, knowing how to effectively use white materials is more important than ever. This involves selecting the right material based on both mechanical and aesthetic considerations, understanding when to use indirect versus direct techniques, and recognising the role of composites not only in conservative dentistry but also in prosthetics, for both provisional and permanent solutions.

Ultimately, effective treatment planning requires focusing on delivering high-quality outcomes while minimising chair time. With these principles in mind, the choice between composites and ceramics is no longer a matter of opposition. Instead, these materials can be used in harmony, even within the same patient's mouth. This allows clinicians to fully leverage the advantages these materials bring to their practice.

ABSTRACT

We've often been told that highly aesthetic restorations require complex, sophisticated methods only achievable by the "gifted." But what if I told you that there's a simple, repeatable method that can achieve perfect restorations with a high success rate?

This approach focuses on 3 key principles: rational colour matching, precise reproduction of the chosen colour, and the ability to learn from mistakes. Material selection, layering techniques, and morphology management are essential to replicate the smallest nuances of a patient's teeth, all while keeping the process manageable.

Some may be surprised by the idea of "simple" aesthetic dentistry, assuming that simplifying the process compromises the quality of the results. In fact, the opposite is true.
