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Synopsis





- Your personal dental loupes if you use them at work
- At least 6 extracted teeth including:
 - Premolar with Weine type II canal configuration (two canals that merge apically)
 - At least one tooth with Weine Type IV canal configuration (canals that bifurcate)
 - Tooth with an oval-shaped canal
 - 2 maxillary molars
 - 2 mandibular molars
 - C-shaped molar


