Introduction

Veneering has become the modern approach for prosthetic solutions, allowing dentists to preserve more natural tooth structure compared to traditional crowns. 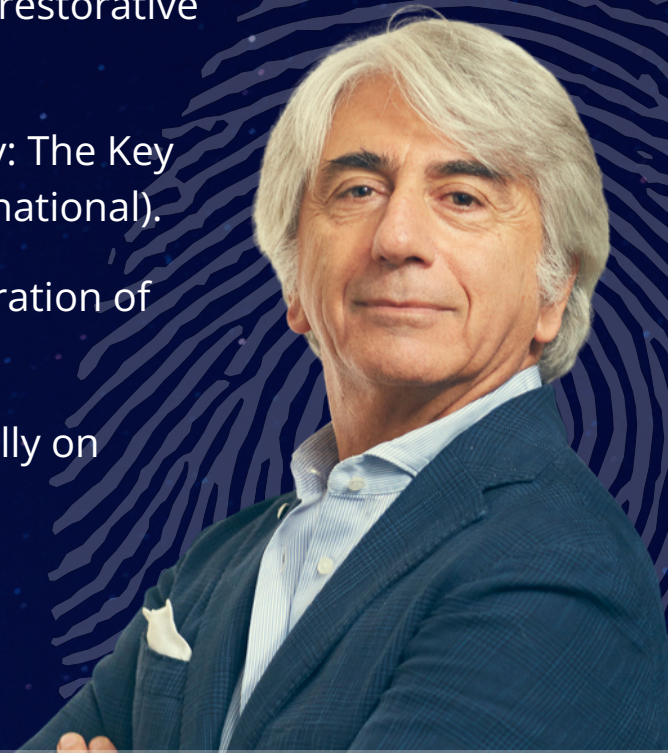

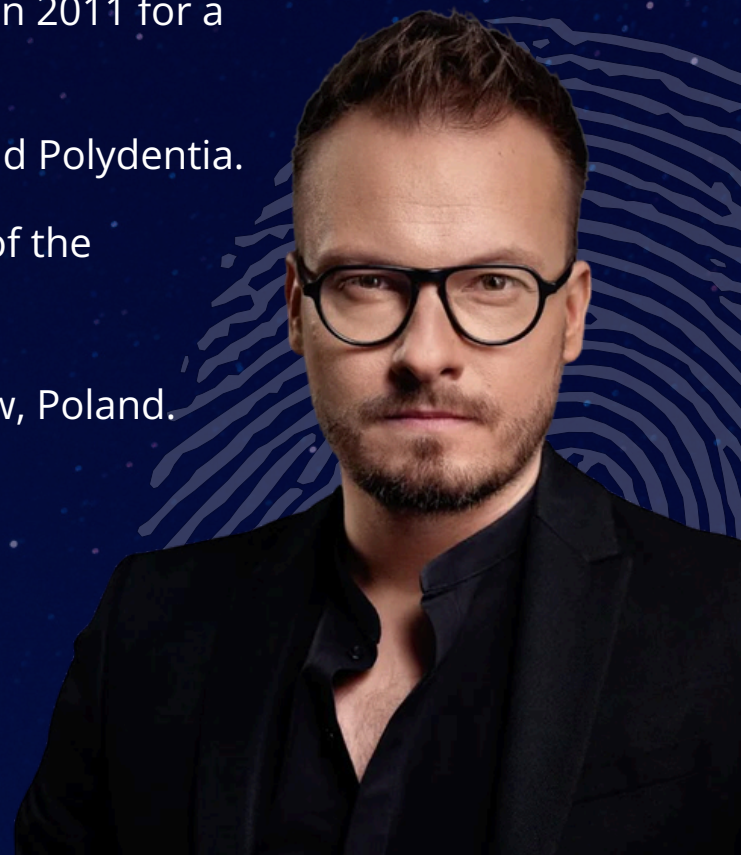
